Notice of Finding of No Significant Impact and Record of Decision

Foy Shaw Parkway

Bob Sikes Airport

The Federal Aviation Administration, Orlando Airports District Office, has announced that a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Record of Decision (ROD) has been approved based on the results of an Environmental Assessment prepared for the proposed Foy Shaw Parkway at the Bob Sikes Airport located in Crestview, Florida.

The FONSI/ROD addressed the proposed construction of a new two-lane arterial access road to provide connection to the Bob Sikes Airport from US Highway 90, near Crestview, Florida. US Highway 90 is a major highway across north Florida and is the primary east/west commercial corridor through the City of Crestview. The proposed alignment begins at the existing intersection of US 90 and Cavalier Drive and continues north on a new alignment for approximately 0.80 miles to the intersection of John Givens Road and Skyline Drive. The new roadway would have two 12-foot paved travel lanes with six-foot shoulders (five-feet of the shoulders would be paved). The roadway would be located within a new 150-foot wide corridor.

The FONSI/ROD indicates that the proposed action is consistent with existing environmental policies and objectives as set forth in the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 in that it will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment.
